Reports generated from these databases clearly communicate to the participants in each of our planning projects the way their campus is using, and can better use, its physical assets. Such analyses underlie all of DLM's utilization studies, peer comparisons, needs projections, and facility programs.

A partial list of projects includes analysis of facilities data from a national survey of college campuses for the Society for Campus and University Planning, a classroom Model for Wayne State University, Space Utilization Analyses for Cornell University, and facility programs for three colleges at Saint Xavier University.
